

Certificate IV in Leadership and Management (BSB42015)

Course Overview:

The Certificate IV in Leadership and Management (BSB42015) is designed to support the development of emerging leaders and managers as well as those who currently fulfil leadership and management roles and are seeking extension or improvement opportunities.

As well as assuming responsibility for their own performance, candidates for this qualification will provide leadership, guidance and support to others. They will also have some responsibility for organising and monitoring the output of their team.

Therefore, the aim of this qualification is to help candidates to become more effective, productive and confident in managing the broad range of functions required for organisations to succeed.

- Learn how to manage critical organisational functions such as leading teams, building relationships, monitoring projects and identifying personal and professional priorities
