Address Foundation Skills in Vocational Practice Skill Set

Course Overview:

This skill set is designed to build the capacity of vocational trainers and assessors to address the foundation skills development needs of learners within their vocational practice. It specifically focuses on enhancing language, literacy and numeracy skills and empowers participants to address adult LLN needs, access appropriate LLN support resources and identify the foundation skills requirements that are critical to vocational competence.

Assessors involved with the Foundation Skills (FSK) Training Package units must possess TAESS00009 Address Foundation Skills in Vocational Practice Skill Set (or equivalent) or a relevant higher level education qualification. The MRWED program is designed to enable practitioners to meet these minimum requirements.

Key Outcomes:

- Identify language, literacy and numeracy (LLN) skill requirements of training and the work environment
- Use resources and strategies that meet the LLN needs of the learner group
- Identify resourcing needs for effective delivery and assessment of foundation skills
- Access resources in order to integrate foundation skills into a vocational training program
- Demonstrate how to plan, design and address foundation skills requirements using integrated approaches.

Modes of Delivery:

- Recognition of Prior Learning (for experienced trainers and assessors who have evidence to support their current competence in the relevant units of competency which comprise the qualification).





Course Structure:

There are 3 units in the Address Foundation Skills in Vocational Practice Skill Set.

- TAELLN411 Address adult language, literacy and numeracy skills
- TAELLN412 Access resources and support to address foundation skills in vocational practice
- TAELLN413 Integrate foundation skills into vocational training delivery

These units are from the TAE Training and Assessment Training Package and may be used to provide credit towards other qualifications such as TAE40116 Certificate IV in Training and Assessment, TAE50116 Diploma of Vocational Education and Training and TAE50216 Diploma of Training Design and Development.

Assessment:

The assessment in this skill set may involve a variety of portfolio activities, practical tasks, presentations, reflective tasks and project work. Participants are supported through their journey by MRWED's dedicated Learner Success Team.
