The Enterprise Trainer-Presenting Skill Set (TAESS00014) provides the necessary skills and knowledge for people training under supervision in the VET sector, who work mainly in classroom situations.

This Skill Set will therefore be suitable for those who are looking to provide on-the-job instruction in a structured training environment within the workplace or in a Registered Training Organisation.

- Implement techniques to review the effectiveness of the presentation.
